WHO'S ELIGIBLE TO BE ELECTED POPE?



Canon law says any unmarried, baptized male Catholic, clergy or not, is eligible to be pope. That said, only cardinals have been elected for the last 600-plus years, so being considered for the position in this case is very much the result of whom you know.

All likely or potential papal candidates are collectively known as "papabile." Politics and personalities aside, one of the paramount considerations when determining papabile is a candidate's age.

The ideal papal candidate is between 60 and 70 years old, with the ideal time in office considered to be from 10 to 12 years. If too young a pope is

elected, he could end up overseeing and influencing church doctrine for decades, since only death or resignation would end their time in the office. Conversely, if too old a candidate is elected they may have little time to make an impact.

THE CONCLAVE: Electing a New Pope	
	
1. Pope Dies or Resigns:	The process begins with the vacancy of the Papal See.
2. Cardinals Gather in Vatican:	Cardinals under 80 years old from around the world convene in Rome.
3. Seclusion ("Conclave"):	They are locked inside the Sistine Chapel, isolated from the outside world. No phones, internet, or contact!
4. Voting by Secret Ballot:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Multiple rounds of voting occur each day. - Each cardinal writes one name on their ballot. - Ballots are counted and then burned.
5. Smoke Signals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Black Smoke: No Pope elected in that round. Chemicals are added to make the smoke black. - White Smoke: A Pope has been elected! Chemicals are added to make the smoke white.

6. Acceptance & Announcement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The elected cardinal is asked if he accepts. * If he accepts, he chooses his papal name. - The senior cardinal announces to the world: "Habemus Papam!" ("We have a Pope!")
7. New Pope Appears:	The new Pope appears on the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica to greet the faithful.
