## **BRAZIL TO DOUBLE DOWN ON BRICS IN DEFIANCE OF DONALD TRUMP**



*Brazil will double down on its commitment to the Brics bloc, as stated by the Brazilian president's top foreign policy adviser, defying US President Donald Trump's threats of punitive tariffs.*

*Trump twice targeted Brazil this month, first threatening a 10% tariff against nations "aligning themselves" with the "anti-American" Brics bloc, then pledging 50% levies on Brazil and demanding an end to Jair Bolsonaro's coup plot trial.*

*Celso Amorim, lead foreign affairs adviser to President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, told the Financial Times these attacks "are reinforcing our relations with the Brics, because we want to have diversified relations and not depend on any one country." Beyond Brics, Brazil aims to bolster relations with countries in Europe, South America, and Asia.*

*The 50% tariff is among the highest Trump has mentioned, despite Brazil running a trade deficit with the US. Trump also criticized Lula's government for "attacks on free speech," a "ridiculous censorship regime," and "very unfair" trade practices.*

*While China is Brazil's largest trading partner, Amorim stated "it's not our intention" for Beijing to be the sole beneficiary of Trump's tariffs. He urged the EU to ratify the long-stalled trade treaty with Mercosur, saying it would provide "not just for the immediate economic gain but also for more balance in its relations."*

*Amorim concluded with the maxim that "countries have no friends, only interests," but called Trump an unusual case with "neither friends nor interests, just wishes," describing his approach as "an illustration of absolute power."*
