



MOVIE REVIEW WITH LOU, GIFTED HANDS: THE BEN CARSON STORY



The Ben Carson Story (2009) is a biographical drama film that involves medicine and a story of overcoming. Directed and produced by Thomas Carter and written by John Pielmeier, the film is based on the autobiography of neurosurgeon Benjamin Carson, who became a politician later.

Ben Carson was considered dumb by his classmates. He wouldn't get any questions right on the exam and didn't have a good imagination. His single mother, Sonya, is frustrated about her son's grades and failures and decides to do something about it, so she requires him and his older brother, Curtis, to study so they can have a bright future that she never had.
